The Surrey and Hants Improvement Partnership (SHIP) is a partnership between eight Local Authorities to formulate a single bid to the Regional Housing Board (RHB). Funding is sought to participate in an enhanced grants programme to tackle fuel poverty for vulnerable owners and tenants of hard-to-heat homes.

The open space is used by housing tenants, Waverley residents and residents of the Longfield Nursing Home. There have been complaints about trips on uneven surfaces.

7 Flooring at Farncombe Day Centre	12,000		Improving the quality of life, particularly for the more vulnerable within our society	Farncombe day centre has been running for more than 20 years and the lino flooring (almost throughout) has not been replaced in almost as many years. Though it has worn well it is looking scuffed and tired and it should be replaced before it rises and becomes a hazard.
