50. <u>MINUTES</u> (Agenda Item 1)

Cllrs Julian Hubble and John Sandy declared personal interests in Agenda Item 6 as members of Go Godalming. Cllr Bryn Morgan declared an interest in the same item as a member of Godalming Rotary Club.

Cllr Hubble also declared a personal interest in Agenda Item 8 as he was present at the meeting of Sub-Committee A on 1 March 2010 in his capacity as ward councillor and in support of the applicant.

Part II - Matters Reported in Detail for the Information of the Council

- 53. <u>STREET COLLECTIONS BANDSTAND IN PHILLIPS MEMORIAL</u> GROUND, GODALMING (Agenda Item 6; Appendix A)
- 53.1 The Committee considered an application for street collection permits from Go Godalming for the 2010 summer season of concerts at the bandstand in the Phillips Memorial Ground.
- 53.2 The Committee discussed the application in detail and concern was raised about equity to other organisations that may wish to organise similar events in the location and raise money themselves over the summer months. It was reported that the application was formalising an arrangement that had existed in previous years and that historically, there had been minimal demand to hold street collections in the Godalming area on Sunday. It was also noted that Go Godalming could advise the Licensing Section if there were any dates during the proposed programme of nineteen Sundays which could be made available to other organisations on request.
- 53.3 The Committee acknowledged the difficulty of the current scheme which permitted street collections to be undertaken across a whole town and recognised that there was merit in investigating the possibility of introducing timed slots and specific locations within a wider area, to enable more than one organisation to collect on the same date but at different times or in different areas.

RESOLVED that

- 1. the applications be granted only for the summer of 2010 for Go Godalming for 18 Sundays for the defined area around the bandstand and for the period of 3.00 p.m. to 5.00 p.m. only; and
- 2. officers be instructed to review the current street collections scheme and report to a future meeting to see if the scheme could be made clearer, so that circumstances such as specific time slots or defined areas might be covered within the revised scheme, as well as those issues set out in paragraph 53.3 above.
