- 41.1 The Executive considered a report, copies of which had previously been circulated to all Members of the Council as Appendix A, seeking authority for the consultation on alternative approaches to delivering new housing and other issues for the Waverley Borough Local Plan.
- 41.2 Cllr Mulliner put forward a number of formatting changes that would help to ensure the clarity of the document and ease of reading for members of the public. The suggestions did not change the substance of what was proposed and therefore the Executive agreed that appropriate amendments would be made in accordance with Recommendation 20 below. The importance of affordable housing numbers was raised and the Executive noted that the current requirement was to identify overall housing numbers at this time.
- 41.3 The Executive confirmed that supporting evidence would be available on the website at the commencement of the consultation and that an easy to understand explanatory leaflet would be sent to every household and business in the borough to encourage wider engagement with members of the public.
