## **ANNEXE 2**

## <u>Explanation of outcome categories used by the Local Government Ombudsman</u>

**MI reps** = where the LGO has concluded an investigation and issued a formal report finding maladministration causing injustice.

**LS** = local settlement where action has been agreed by the LA and accepted by the LGO as a satisfactory outcome.

**M** reps = where the LGO has concluded an investigation and issued a formal report finding maladministration but causing no injustice to the complainant.

**NM** reps = where the LGO has concluded an investigation and issued a formal report finding no maladministration by the Council.

**No Mal** = decisions by letter discontinuing an investigation because no, or insufficient, evidence of maladministration.

**Omb disc** = a decision by the LGO to exercise his general discretion not to pursue a complaint. This can be for a variety of reasons, but the most common is that the Ombudsman has found no or insufficient injustice to warrant pursuing the matter further.

**Outside jurisdiction** = these are cases which are outside the Ombudsman's jurisdiction.
