5. **APPLICATION WA/2008/0788 RELATING TO LAND AT DUNSFOLD PARK, STOVOLDS HILL, CRANLEIGH GU8 4BS**

[Alfold, Cranleigh Rural & Ellens Green]

Part OUTLINE application for a new settlement of 2,601 new dwellings comprising 2,405 independent dwellings, 150 sheltered housing/warden accommodation and 96 student accommodation; Erection of buildings to provide the following (the maximum amount of floor space is given in brackets): A1 Shops (1,035m²); A3 Restaurants/Cafes (230 m²); A4 Public House (115m²); A5 Take Away (115m²); B1a and B1b Business use including Offices and Research and Development (9,440 m²); B1c and B2 Light and General Industrial use (6,099 m²); B8 Storage and Distribution (7,624m²); C1 Hotel (7,015m²); D1 Non-Residential Institutions including health centre, two schools, place of worship, museum and community centre (9,906m²); D2 Assembly and Leisure use including sports centre (2,185 m²); Monument; combined heat and power plant; together with associated works following demolition of 8, 029m² of existing buildings and removal of runways. Part FULL application for the Change of Use of 36,692m² of existing buildings as specified, retention of aviation use solely for helicopter flights including air ambulance service, use of land for outdoor sports and recreational facilities. (abbreviated description)

A full report on the above application is attached as APPENDIX A. At the Technical Briefing on 3 September 2008 Members heard from the applicants, parish councils and other interested parties, and were able to ask questions of a technical nature. A summary of the questions and answers is attached Annexe 1.

Recommendation

The Committee is recommended to REFUSE planning permission, for the reasons set out on pages 71 and 72 of Appendix A.
