- At a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.

a) General — all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e)

The licensee shall have regard to the risk assessment for the premises.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

Any regulated entertainment shall cease a minimum of 1 hour before closing time. The permitted hours set out in the licence shall be observed.

c) Public Safety

The licensee shall have regard to and comply with the measures identified in the Fire Safety and the Health and Safety Risk Assessments.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

Staff shall monitor the noise levels to ensure no public nulsance is caused. IStaff shall request that customers leave quietly in order to respect the needs of neighbours

e) The protection of children from harm

Children under the age of 14 shall not be permitted in the bar area.
