To whom it may concern,

I contacted your office today with regards to the late licence application being displayed in the Ball & Wicket public house in Farnham. I was very concerned to learn that the late licence application is to serve alcohol and food until 12 midnight on weekdays and 1am on Fridays and Saturdays.

Being a local resident (I live in ......) my biggest concern is the added late night noise this could create. The area surrounding the pub is heavily residential and therefore there are many residents who will have to endure patrons of the Ball & Wicket leaving the pub in the early hours and the associated noise this will inevitably cause. The pub has recently successfully applied for a kitchen flue in order to commence serving food, this will mean that residents will also have to endure the cooking smells caused by serving food until times which i believe are unacceptable in a residential area.

I am also concerned that the increased opening times will allow for more time for alcohol to be consumed which could lead to anti social behaviour potentially affecting local residents property. There are more and more reports in the news of increasing anti social behaviour and i therefore do not see why we should invite such a potential problem by increasing drinking time.

Due to the reasons above i am heavily opposed to this late licence application and would ask that permission is not permitted.
