LICENSING ACT 2003 - APPLICATION FOR A NEW PREMISES LICENCE – CO-OP, 47-51 FARNBOROUGH ROAD, FARNHAM, SURREY, GU9 9AJ

[Wards Affected: Farnham Hale and Heath End]

Summary and Purpose

1. The purpose of the report is to enable the Sub-Committee to consider an application from Southern Co-operatives Limited, for a new premises licence for Co-op, 47-51 Farnborough Road, Farnham, Surrey, GU9 9AJ where representations have been received from an interested party.

Background

2. An application has been received for a new premises licence from the Co-op who are due to operate from this premises (current operator - Bennets Electrical) to sell a range of goods. The application proposes that the licence will allow the premises to sell alcohol for consumption off the premises.

Activities Sought under this Licence Application

3. The applicant seeks to licence the premises as shown below. An extract of the relevant pages from the application form is attached at Annexe 1. Attached to this document at Annexe 2 are some amendments to the application following discussions between the applicant and Surrey police. Also attached at Annexe 3 is a plan showing the premises and surrounding properties. In brief summary, the applicant seeks the following activities in the new licence, if granted. Please see application for activities in full.

- Sale of Alcohol
0800 to 2300 Monday to Sunday
- Opening hours:
0600 to 2300 Monday to Sunday

Licensing Objectives

4. The four Licensing Objectives of the Licensing Act 2003 are set out below. Any representations for consideration must relate to one or more of these objectives, and representations must be from interested parties and/or from the responsible authorities under this legislation.

1. Prevention of Crime and Disorder
2. Public Safety
3. Prevention of Nuisance
4. Protection of Children from Harm

Representations received

Responsible Authorities

5. There have been no representations from Responsible Authorities

Interested Parties

6. There has been one representation from an Interested Party, and this is reproduced at Annexe 4.

What the Sub-Committee may do

7. The Sub-Committee, after hearing from the applicant and those making representations, may take one or more of the steps listed below in order to promote the Licensing Objectives which have given rise to the representations in this case. Reasons must be given by the Sub-Committee for any decision made, since there is an opportunity for any applicant or any objector to appeal to the Magistrates' Court against the Licensing Sub-Committee decision. The Sub-Committee may:

- Grant the application as submitted; or
- Refuse the application; or
- Reduce or refuse parts of the application submitted,
- Add conditions to meet the Licensing Objectives if the Sub-Committee considers it necessary in the light of the representation received.

8. An extract from the Government Guidance to local authorities under Section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003, as it applies to this application - paragraphs 9.19 to 9.28 - is attached as Annexe 5.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the application for a premises licence for Co-op, 47-51 Farnborough Road, Farnham, Surrey, GU9 9AJ be considered and determined having regard to the representations received, the statutory guidance and the Council's Statement of Licensing Policy 2011 - 2013. The Sub-Committee must take such steps (if any) as it considers necessary to promote the Licensing Objectives, having heard from the applicant and those making written representations.
