Russets

Operating Schedule

Preamble

Russets is a country house set in substantial grounds and run by the Applicants who are the owners of the freehold of the premises.

The premises have undergone extensive refurbishment and in addition to separate living accommodation for them and their children, comprises facilities for the holding of private events including private parties and small conferences together [subject to obtaining the appropriate Licence] with weddings.

The Applicants do not intend that there should be any casual drinking and their admission policy, pricing structure and the substantial investment they have made in the premises militates against the risk of a booking that would be likely to cause a breach of any of the Licensing Objectives. Furthermore as the premises also comprise their home the Applicants have no desire to entertain any inappropriate use of the building.

The supply of alcohol for consumption off the premises is applied for to cover such private events as a wine tasting where as well as sampling the alcohol on offer the attendees will also be entitled to purchase same to take away.

The Applicants have included in the area to be covered in the Licence the grounds. This is so that a marquee can be erected and used for Licensable Activities and, for instance, a group of strolling players may perform, and alcohol supplied in the building or a marquee or temporary bar situated in the grounds can be consumed within the area covered by the Licence.

Conditions

The Applicants invite the Licensing Authority to impose the following Conditions in the Premises Licence.

- 1. No Licensable Activities including the supply of alcohol for consumption off the premises shall take place on the premises save in connection with the holding at the premises of a bona fide private function.
- 2. Licensable Activities may only take place within the building on the premises or in a marquee erected in the grounds of the premises save that strolling players may perform in the grounds and alcohol may be consumed by attendees in the grounds when dispensed in the building or a marquee or from a temporary bar situated on the premises.
- 3. All Licensable Activities save for those taking place within the building situated on the premises or in a marquee situated in the grounds of the premises shall cease at 23:00 on Mondays to Saturdays and at 22:00 on Sundays.

Compliance with the Licensing Objectives

Prevention of Crime and Disorder

The premises do not lend themselves by virtue of their location and the nature of the Licensable Activities to be carried on and the restriction on those who can attend to the likelihood of Crime and Disorder. However the Applicants are mindful of the need to ensure that only those invited to attend a private function are present on the premises. They are also acutely aware that some attendees may seek to consume too much alcohol or act in a boisterous manner. Accordingly to prevent excessive drinking or rowdiness the Applicants will train all their staff and will themselves ensure that any person who appears to be consuming too much alcohol or may behave in an antisocial manner is restrained and if necessary removed from the premises.

Public Safety

)

The premises have been extensively renovated and all the necessary fire extinguishers, emergency lighting, CCTV and other precautions taken after risk assessments have been carried out by the Applicants will be in place and reviewed from time to time and be the subject of at least annual checks. The wiring has been replaced and is the subject of a certificate in this regard. Access by wheelchair users has been provided and the staff will be trained in the proper means of exiting the premises safely in the case of e.g. fire. No particular exceptional hazards are present on the premises and the Applicants will comply with any restriction on numbers that the Responsible Authorities may require.

The Prevention of Public Nuisance

In addition to the matters referred to above the Applicants will use their best endeavours to ensure that attendees leave the premises in an orderly fashion, do not drive away noisily or when clearly having had too much to drink. The location of the premises some way away from the nearest conurbation and situated down a long drive is not conducive to outsiders gate-crashing events, but, as stated above the Applicants will use their best endeavours to ensure that this does not happen.

The Prevention of Children from Harm

There are no particular hazards likely to cause such harm on the premises. However no children will be permitted on the premises unless supervised by a responsible adult. The Applicants are in particular aware of the need to ensure that those underage do not consume alcohol either by purchasing or otherwise obtaining it themselves or consuming it when it has been obtained by an adult. The Applicants will adopt an over 25 policy and train their staff to do so. When the premises are booked for a private event the Applicants will ensure that the person making such a booking is aware of this policy and of the need for those who may appear to be under 25 to produce evidence that they are adults before they will be supplied with or permitted to consume alcohol.
