Our home is approximately [REDACTED] from the premises Russets and as such will be directly affected by the activities proposed by in the residents of this property.

We are currently in a quiet, residential location that provides a safe environment for our family including young children [REDACTED]

Our main concern is that the noise of:- guests arriving and leaving the premises at unsociable hours; the actual functions themselves and the associated activities inside & outside the premises, will cause Public nuisance. Our secondary concern is the increase in traffic from delivery lorries and guests arriving and leaving functions on an already busy and hazardous road.

Re: License Application for Russets, Petworth Road, Chiddingfold, Surrey

We are writing to object to the license application for at the above property under the licensing objective of prevention of public nuisance.

We live within [REDACTED] of this property and are part of a small quiet, rural residential area and it is our concern that if this license were granted we would be disturbed by any noise from music 'breakout', deliveries, clearing up, people being outdoors at the property, guests arriving and departing especially at unsocial hours and any other noise associated with this type of venue such as firework displays etc.

All the residents close to this property have young children, work or as in my case have a long term illness and so would find any noise a disturbance, especially late at night when we are trying to sleep.

Also if this license were granted we are concerned that there would be an increase in traffic on what is already a busy and hazardous road.

Over the past few months there have already been some functions held at Russets where we could hear the music being played and one night we were disturbed at around midnight by a noisy firework display and then the guests cheering and clapping afterwards. Not only did we find very intrusive but rather alarming at this time of night. Also this must have been distressing to the horses and other livestock that are in the fields next to us.

Although we strongly object to this license application we would ask that if it is granted that you consider stipulating earlier finishing times of either 11.30pm or 12 midnight and then 10pm on Sunday evenings rather than proposed times.

We trust that our concerns and comments will be given full and careful consideration when you are deciding on this application

We would be grateful if you could keep us informed of the outcome of this license application.
