**NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO REVIEW A PREMISES
LICENCE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an application has been made to the Licensing Authority of WAVERLEY BOROUGH COUNCIL for review of a premises licence under Section 51 of the Licensing Act 2003. Details of the grounds of the application for review of the licence are as follows:-

Mr Ibrahim Ates is the licence holder and the Designated Premises Supervisor for the Wine House. Mr Ates has failed to comply with the Licensing Objectives relating to Prevention of Crime and Disorder and Protection of Children from Harm. The Review seeks to resolve the failure to promote the Licensing Objectives contained within the Licensing Act 2003.

Any responsible authority or interested party wishing to make representations on this matter/matters relating to the four licensing objectives of the Licensing Act 2003 must submit those representations in writing to Licensing Section, Waverley Borough Council, Council Offices, The Burys, Godalming, Surrey, GU7 1HR by not later than **Wednesday, 4th January 2012** stating the grounds on which the representation is made. Written representations may also be made by e-mail to: licensing@waverley.gov.uk. The application papers may be viewed by appointment at the Council Offices.

Please note that it is an offence under Section 158 of the Licensing Act 2003 knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with an application for review and any person making such a statement shall be liable, on summary conviction, to a fine not exceeding level five on the standard scale (currently £5,000).
