Dear Vicki,

As you are aware, I am in receipt of an application for a new premises licence for an ASK Restaurant at Unit RU5, Borelli Square, Farnham, Surrey.

This is believed to be part of the new Brightwells development in Farnham which is yet to be built.

Our understanding is that there will be new residential premises built in the near vicinity of a number of restaurants and cafes including ASK

We believe that the operating schedule does not sufficiently address the promotion of the licensing objectives and would therefore like the following conditions attached to the operating schedule

1. A comprehensive digital colour CCTV system will be installed at the premises. Cameras will be situated to include coverage of the outside seating area. The system will be maintained and operational at all times the premises are open for business. Video recordings shall be available for a minimum of 28 days and shall be made available to an authorised officer or police officer together with facilities for viewing. There will be a capability to download to CD/DVD.

- 3. Staff engaged in the sale of alcohol shall be trained in the law relating to the sale/supply of alcohol and written records will be kept for inspection. This will include the law relating to both the sale and the consumption of alcohol to persons under 18 and the refusal of sale of alcohol to persons who are drunk. There will be an ongoing training regime with refresher/reinforcement training at intervals of no more than six months.
- 3. The premises will operate a Challenge 21 policy and will only accept passport, photo driving licence or ID cards bearing the PASS hologram as forms of identification.
- 4. The supply of alcohol will be by waiter/waitress service only
- 5. The outside areas will not be used for the consumption of alcohol or food after 23:00
- 6. No glasses or bottles will be allowed to be taken outside after 23:00
- 7. An incident log shall be kept at the premises, and made available on request to an authorised officer of the Borough Council or the Police, which will record the following:
 - a. All crimes reported to the venue
 - b. All ejections of patrons
 - c. Any incidents of disorder
 - d. Seizures of drugs or offensive weapons
 - e. Any faults in the CCTV system
 - f. Any refusal of the sale of alcohol
 - g. Any visit by a relevant authority or emergency service

We have been in negotiations with the applicants and understand that they have now submitted an amendment to the application to include the following conditions:


- 1. A comprehensive digital colour CCTV system will be installed at the premises. Cameras will be situated to include coverage of the outside seating area. The system will be maintained and operational at all times the premises are open for business. Video recordings shall be available for a minimum of 28 days and shall be made available to an authorised officer or police officer together with facilities for viewing. There will be a capability to download to CD/DVD.
- 2. Staff engaged in the sale of alcohol shall be trained in the law relating to the sale/supply of alcohol and written records will be kept for inspection. This will include the law relating to both the sale and the consumption of alcohol to persons under 18 and the refusal of sale of alcohol to persons who are drunk. There will be an ongoing training regime with refresher/reinforcement training at intervals of no more than 12 months.
- 3. The premises will operate a Challenge 21 policy and will only accept passport, photo driving licence or ID cards bearing the PASS hologram as forms of identification.
- 4. The supply of alcohol will be by waiter/waitress service only

- 5. The outside areas will not be used for the consumption of alcohol or food after 23:00
- 6. No glasses or bottles will be allowed to be taken outside after 23:00
- 7. An incident log shall be kept at the premises, and made available on request to an authorised officer of the Borough Council or the Police, which will record the following:
 - a. All crimes reported to the venue
 - b. All ejections of patrons
 - c. Any incidents of disorder
 - d. Seizures of drugs or offensive weapons
 - e. Any faults in the CCTV system
 - f. Any refusal of the sale of alcohol
 - g. Any visit by a relevant authority or emergency service

This now allays our concerns and therefore Surrey Police have no objections to the grant of a premises licence under Section 17 of the Licensing Act 2003.

I wish the following comment to be considered when the above application comes up for decision:

Existing restaurant and cafe/bar outlets in Farnham town centre must not be disadvantaged by any more favourable licensing conditions that might be allowed to new retailers in the East Street/Brightwells development. I have noted the conditions of the application from Ask Restaurants and compared these to licensing applicable to the Borelli Wine Bar. For instance, Ask has applied for recorded music with opening hours from 11 am to 12.30 am on every day of the week but I am told that the Borelli Wine Bar is licensed for opening only on six days and only up to midnight. I would be very concerned if a different standard is applied, as we are told to expect numbers of similar openings in the new development. The Ask Restaurant premises could well be the one to set a precedent and it must be the right precedent.

I believe it to be very important that due consideration is given to those hundreds of residents who may have homes within, around and very close the new development and that they have a reasonable time off from the inevitable noise and disturbance generated by customers from licensed premises. Town centre residents need to sleep!

I write as a resident of Farnham who has an interest in the maintenance of a peaceful and well-regulated night-time economy in my town centre.

I write on behalf of the Farnham Society and its members who may be affected by this application if it is approved.

The Society has no objection to the application for "Recorded music and opening hours 11:00-00:30 Monday to Sunday" which is broadly in line with the application granted to the Odeon Cinema in the same area and other restaurants in Farnham. It is also broadly in line with the two other ASK Restaurants in Waverley in Haslemere and Cranleigh. Neither of these ASK Restaurants have recorded music licenses but we do not object to this facility in Farnham.

For the same reasons we have **no objection** to the application for "On sales of alcohol 11:00-00:00 Monday to Sunday".

However we **do object** to the application for "Late night refreshment 23:00-00:30 Monday to Sunday" There are already more than sufficient "take away" food suppliers in this part of Farnham to meet this requirement. This activity inevitable creates noise and litter nuisance to local residents and we do not wish this to be increased in this area of Farnham. Neither of the Haslemere and Cranleigh ASK Restaurants have late night refreshment licenses, so this is clearly not a standard part of their business operations.

We would also object to the application "off sales of alcohol 11:00-00:00 Monday to Sunday". Again there are more than sufficient off license premises in this area of Farnham. This activity inevitable creates noise and litter nuisance to local residents, especially late at night, and we do not wish this to be increased in this area of Farnham. The Haslemere ASK Restaurant does not have an off premises alcohol license, though the Cranleigh ASK restaurant does, possibly reflecting a genuine local requirement in this large village.

In support of our objections we would ask that in particular consideration should be given to the effects on the quality of life of the residents of the nearby sheltered and retirement housing schemes, who will all have already experienced years of disruption to their lives if the construction of this development goes ahead. These are Faulkner Court with 27 self-contained flats, Riverside Court with 29 self-contained flats and Homepark House with 54 one bedroom flats.

I would be obliged if you could indicate exactly which premises ASK intend to occupy in the proposed development. One of our members believes that it will be unit RU6 in the D8 block beside the proposed Odeon Cinema. As the plans for this block have not been updated from the previously planned larger Vue cinema, he believes that planning consent for this block is not currently valid and this licensing application should not proceed until this is rectified. I quote from his email

"My objection is to the fact that the ASK Licensing Application is based on plans for premises that have no planning consent, because the assumed WA/2012/0912 consent is for the unfinished and obsolete Vue design of D8, rather than the merely unfinished Odeon design.

Though it may be a given that the replacement Odeon design (upon which the ASK application is based) will in future be agreed under an NMA, the Licensing Committee have no right to predetermine a planning decision."

Could you please advise me if this objection to the application being considered is valid in your view.
