A 30 minute drinking up time on top of the last permitted sale of alcohol to allow customers to use the toilet facilities and disperse from the premises.

#### **ELEMENTS OF OPERATING SCHEDULE TO ADDRESS LICENSING OBJECTIVES:**

#### a) General - all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e)

The extended period between the cessation of the supply of alcohol and the closure of the premises is to allow for a more gradual dispersal of customers.

Non-alcoholic refreshment shall be available in the extended period.

The premises shall respect the Spirit Group's "Approach to Responsible Drinking".

Policies shall be adapted at regular intervals to reflect current trends and needs.

#### b) The prevention of crime and disorder

When door staff are used they shall be Security Industry Authority (SIA) approved and shall operate in accordance with the security industry guidelines.

A zero tolerance towards illegal drugs shall be enforced at all times.

If a disc jockey is used on any night he/she shall ask customers to leave quietly.

All instances of crime and disorder shall be reported to the Police and shall be kept in an incident log book.

Additional patrols by members of staff shall be taken of the front outside seating area.

#### c) Public Safety

Public safety shall be integral to the way that the premises are run and shall be reviewed regularly through health and safety policy.

This policy shall be fully briefed and trained to all management and staff.

All management and staff shall be trained to the standards required by relevant legislation.

Free drinking water shall be available at all times.

The front outside table and seating shall be situated away from the main entrance way to the bar area.

Canvas barrier fencing shall be used to define the public footpath from the front outside seating area, where appropriate and as required.

j) the supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to persons employed there for the purposes of the business carried on by the holder of the licence, or the consumption of alcohol so supplied, if the liquor is supplied at the expense of their employer or of the person carrying on or in charge of the business on the premises.

#### The licensee may also provide and permit:

- Entertainment by way of music and singing but <u>only</u> by the reproduction of recorded sound (this does not permit the use of karaoke, disk jockeys, comperes etc).
- The consumption of late night refreshment for a period of 30 minutes after the permitted hours set out below.

#### Cinematograph Licence (video jukebox) Embedded Conditions:-

- 1. The licensee shall ensure that any music provided at the premises shall not cause a disturbance to local residents and that any form of amplification shall be so controlled by the licensee as to prevent such disturbance, and provide suitable approved equipment capable of automatically limiting amplification to an approved level.
- 2. Each and every window in the ground floor of the premises shall be secured and fixed closed at all times the licence is in operation.
- 3. A suitable and adequate ventilation system shall be maintained to the satisfaction of the Licensing Authority.

#### Conditions agreed with Surrey Police:-


- 4. The beer garden is not to be used for the consumption of alcohol and food after 23:00 hours.
- 5. There shall not be any seating provided to the front of the premises and neither shall this area be used for the consumption of alcohol or food at the front of the premises.

#### Conditions agreed with the Environmental Health Officer:-

- All external doors and windows shall be kept closed after 23:00 hours.
- 7. Notices will be placed prominently at all public exits requesting customers to leave quietly.

#### Additional conditions:-

- 8. The outside seating area to the front of the premises shall only be used between the hours of 10:00 and 22:00.
- 9. The front outside seating area tables and chairs shall be vacated and removed by 22:00 hours.
- 10. The front outside seating area shall not be used for the consumption of alcohol or food after 22:00 hours.
- 11. No glasses or bottles shall be allowed to be taken outside after 22:00 hours.
- 12. All staff shall be trained in the basic law relating to the sale/supply of alcohol and written records shall be kept for inspection. This shall include the law relating to both the sale and consumption of alcohol to persons under 18 and the refusal of sale of alcohol to persons who are drunk. There shall be an ongoing training regime.

Licensing Act 2003 – Application for Premises Licence

Premises: The Richard Onslow, High Street, Cranleigh

Surrey Police, as a Responsible Authority under Section 13(4) (b) of the Licensing Act 2003, wish to make a formal representation against the application for a premises licence

The objection is based on our concerns over one or more of the licensing objectives:

The Prevention of Crime and Disorder	 <b>√</b> ,
Public Safety	 ✓
The Prevention of Public Nuisance	<b>√</b>
The Protection of Children from Harm	 ✓

The reasons for Police objections are as follows:

The Richard Onslow currently has a Premises Licence allowing them to trade until midnight Monday to Saturday and until 23:30 on Sundays.

Major refurbishing work is being carried out at the premises and the application is now for a new Premises Licence to sell alcohol until 00:30 and close at 01:00 seven days a week.

The current licence has a number of conditions attached to it which we feel should also be included and updated in the new licence due to the extended hours being applied for.

It is felt that the following conditions should be added to the operating schedule:

1. From the commencement of the Premises Licence the licence holder shall maintain a comprehensive digital colour CCTV system at the premises that ensures all public areas of the licensed premises are monitored, including all public entry and exit points, and which enables frontal identification of every person entering in any light condition. This to include the outside seating areas at the front of the premises and the rear outside seating area. All cameras shall continually record whilst the premises are open to the public and video recordings shall be available for a minimum of 31 days with time and date stamping. Recordings shall be made available to an authorised officer or police officer together with facilities for viewing. There will be a capability to download to CD/DVD

The recording system will be locked in a secure cupboard together with the mains supply.

- 2. Staff involved in the sale of alcohol shall be trained in the basic law relating to the sale/supply of alcohol and written records will be kept for inspection. This will include the law relating to both the sale and the consumption of alcohol to persons under18 and the refusal of sale of alcohol to persons who are drunk. There will be an ongoing training regime.
- 3. The front outside areas will not be used for the consumption of alcohol or food after 22:00
- 4. The rear outside areas will not be used for the consumption of alcohol or food after 23:00
- 5. No glasses or bottles will be allowed to be taken to the outside areas at the front of the premises after 22:00
- 6. No glasses or bottles will be allowed to be taken to the outside areas at the rear of the premises after 23:00
- 7. An incident log shall be kept at the premises, and made available on request to an authorised officer of the Borough Council or the Police, which will record the following:
  - a. All crimes reported to the venue
  - b. All ejections of patrons
  - c. Any complaints received
  - d. Any incidents of disorder
  - e. Seizures of drugs or offensive weapons
  - f. Any faults in the CCTV system
  - g. Any refusal of the sale of alcohol
  - h. Any visit by a relevant authority or emergency service
