#### Recommendation

4. <u>LICENSING ACT 2003 - APPLICATION FOR A NEW PREMISES LICENCE, THE VILLAGERS, WOODSIDE ROAD, CHIDDINGFOLD, SURREY, GU8</u> 4QD.

[Ward Affected: Chiddingfold & Dunsfold Ward]

The purpose of the report at <u>Appendix B</u> is to enable the Sub-Committee to consider an application from Chiddingfold Ex-Servicemens Club Committee, for a new premises licence for The Villagers, Woodside Road, Chiddingfold, Surrey GU8 4QD, where one valid representation has been received.

## Recommendation
