The van will comply with all requisite health and safety legislation for Fire Safety and Health and Safety including periodic risk assessments.

D- The Prevention of Public Nuisance

We are fully aware of local concerns and every effort will be made to ensure that a common sense approach will be given to each individual situation. People who are going to use the business will be asked to consider the neighbours and advise people to wait in a quiet and considerate manner.

Facilities for depositing litter and the collection of litter generated by patrons will be available and maintained.

At close of business, all litter attributable to the business which is in the vicinity of the van will be removed.

We are going to turn our generator off after 11pm.

Regular maintenance will be carried out on all plant and machinery to ensure that noise disturbance from such sources is kept to a minimum.

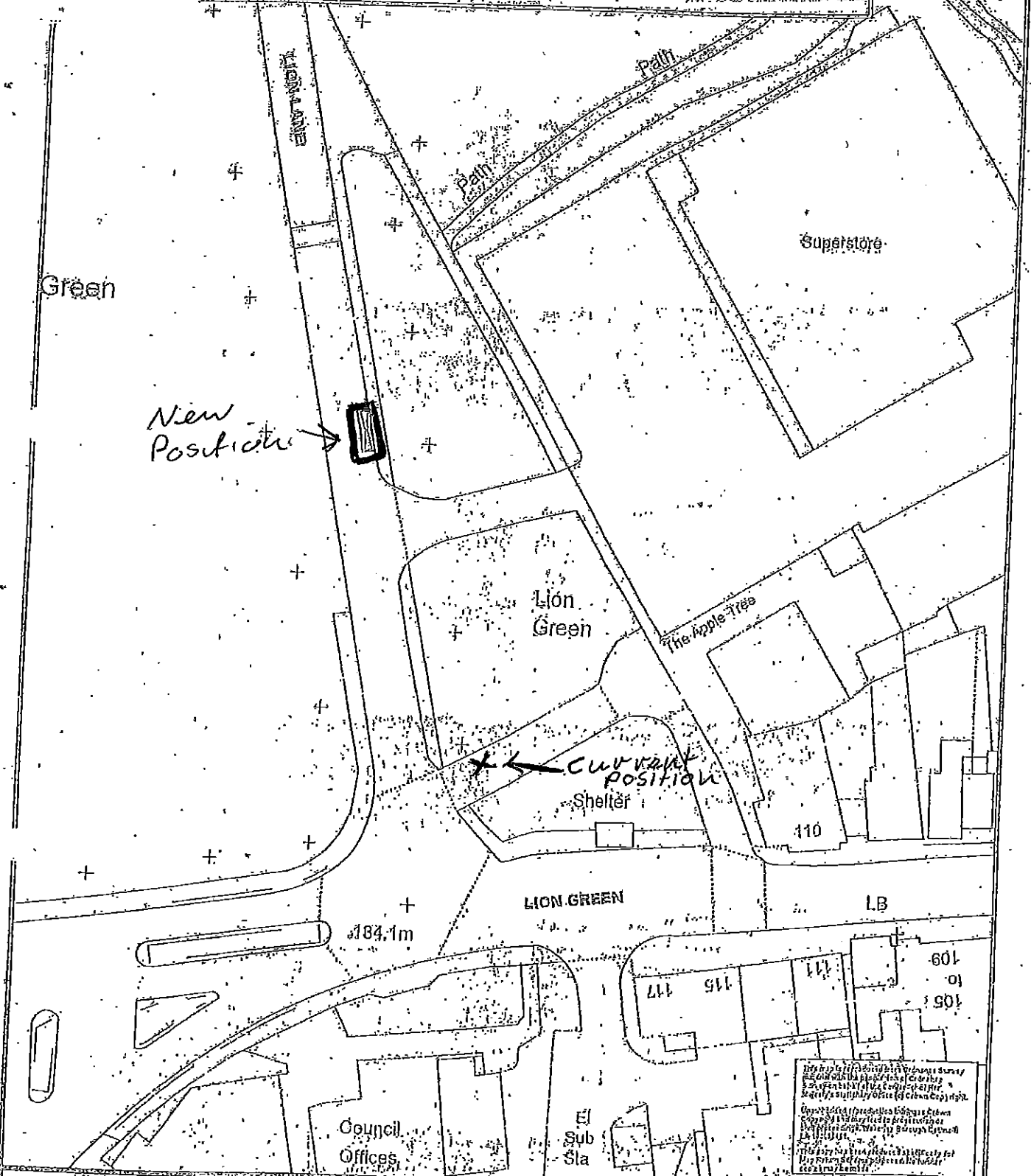

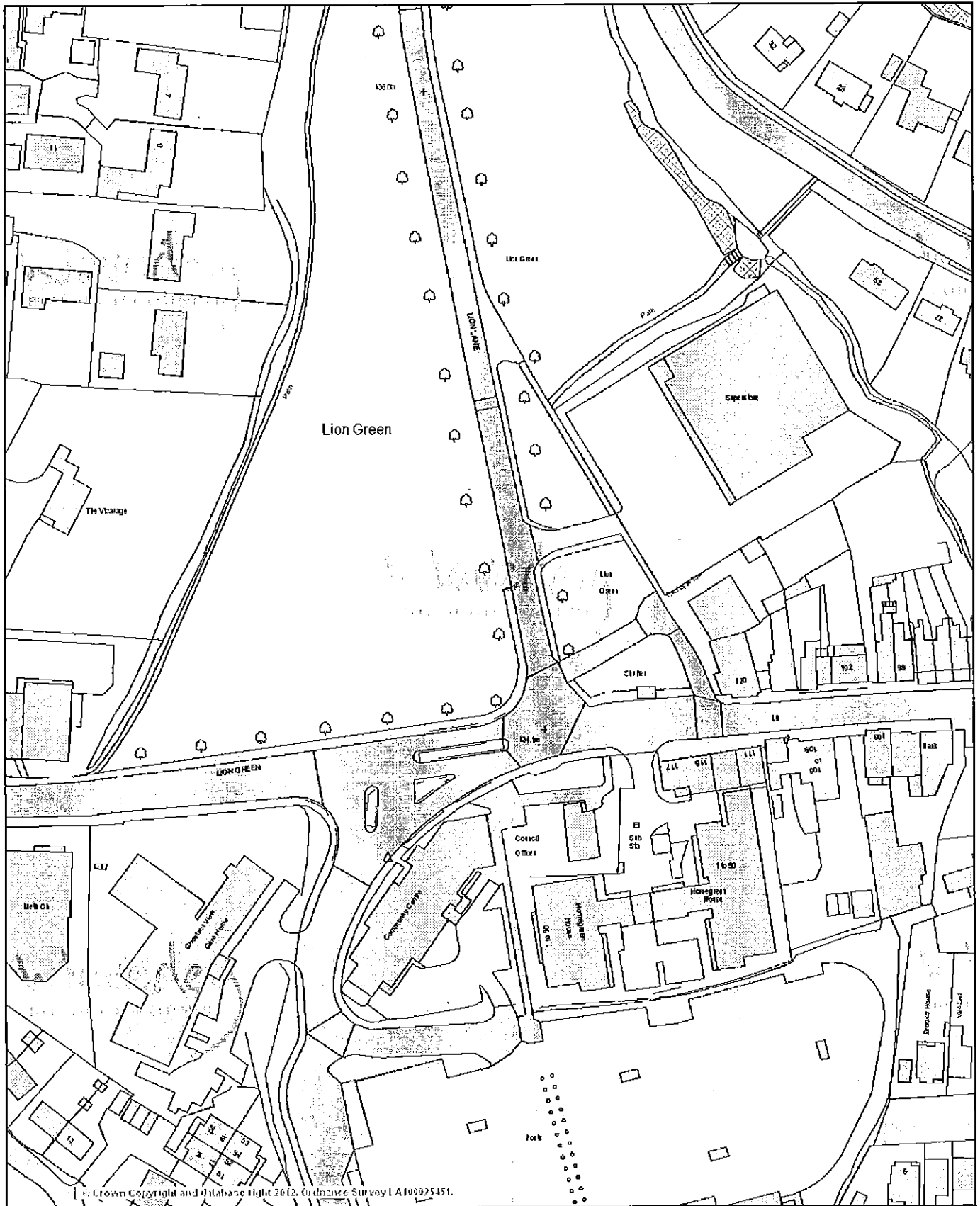

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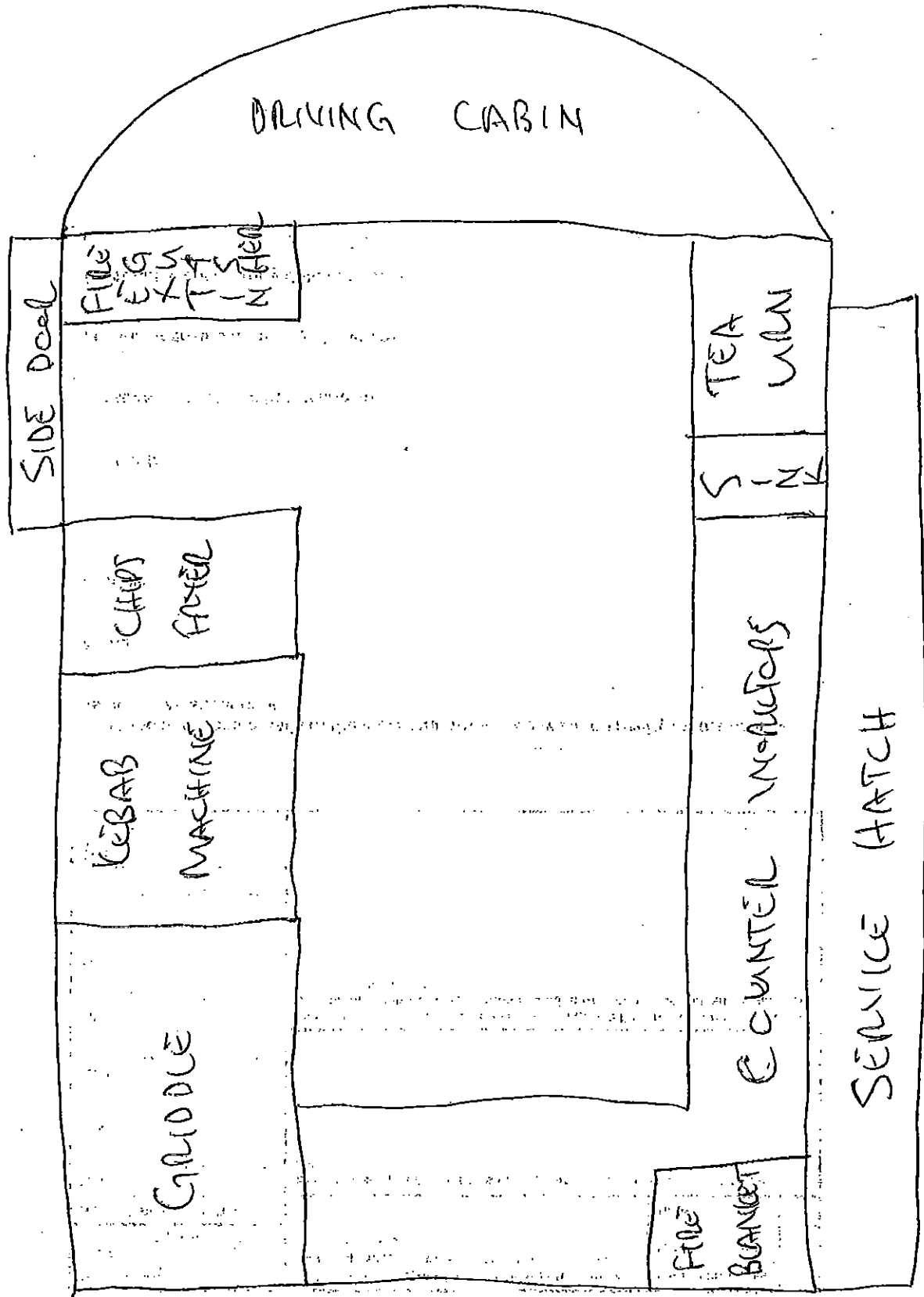
Lion Green Haslemere

1. The premises licence holder shall ensure that the vehicle is removed from the site at the end of each working night.
2. The vehicle shall leave the site within 15 minutes of the end of trading hours
3. No food for off-sales/home deliveries shall be permitted after the licensed trading hours.
4. There shall always be a charged mobile telephone on the premises to call the police in the event of an incident or disturbance.
5. Prominent, clear and legible notices shall be displayed at the premises requesting customers to respect the needs of local residents and to keep noise to a minimum whilst using the premises.

6. An incident log shall be kept at the premises, and made available on request to an authorised officer of the Borough Council or the Police, which will record the following:
 - a) All crimes reported to the venue
 - b) Any incidents of disorder
 - c) Any visit by a relevant authority or emergency service

This now allays our concerns and therefore Surrey Police have no objections to the grant of a premises licence under Section 17 of the Licensing Act 2003.

Premises Licence for Haslemere Burger and Kebab Van

Dear Sir or Madam,

I would like to make an objection to the application for a new premises licence for the Haslemere Burger and Kebab Van.

I understand that the application is related to the removal of the Kebab Van from its present location near the Apple Tree to a location in Lion Green. He has been successful in this application before but in reality has never moved from the location where he is currently trading near the Apple Tree. I now believe that he is being restricted from trading at that location.

Previously the outlined location on Lion Green has been directly outside of the co-op but my current understanding is that due to problems with delivery lorries to the co-op, that Haslemere Town Council have made representations to SCC Highways that the first two parking spaces outside of the co-op be removed and replaced with double yellow lines. If that is the case, the result will certainly move him to a position directly in line with the children's play area on Lion Green which is totally unacceptable both from an early evening perspective when young children are using the play equipment and again to a late night perspective when there will be all the associated noise and disruption to local residents with late night trading.

I believe that Lion Green is dedicated as a Village Green and although Lion Lane dissects the Green it is just not the place to have mobile food trader.

If his current location which directly faces a main road and on the edge of the Green is deemed unacceptable then I do not see how you could grant permission for him to trade in a far quieter position on the centre of the Green. Within Haslemere, Lion Green is seen as the 'Jewel in the Crown' with respect to open spaces and this application is a total misuse of a Village Green.

To add insult to injury the application is to provide late night refreshment to midnight on Sunday to Thursday and then to 1:00 am on Friday and Saturday over 365 days a year on a Village Green that is surrounded by residential properties.

I would therefore ask you to say no and refuse the application for a premises licence.
