14. <u>LICENSING ACT 2003 - APPLICATION TO VARY A PREMISES LICENCE - TESCO EXPRESS, 29/31 RIDGWAY ROAD, FARNHAM SURREY GU9 8NN</u> (Agenda item 3.)

The Sub-Committee carefully considered the application for a variation to the premises licence, taking into account the representation(s) received, statutory guidance and the Council's Statement of Licensing Policy 2013-2018.

The Sub-Committee agreed to grant the variation to the licence as it did not consider that there was sufficient substantiated evidence to reject the application on the grounds of Prevention of Crime & Disorder or Prevention of Nuisance

In granting the application the Sub-Committee noted that there were no representations from the police for antisocial behaviour nor had environmental health made objections for public nuisance. The Sub-Committee heard from the applicant that there had only been one complaint since November 2017 regarding a delivery being early and the Sub-Committee was satisfied that the store had procedures in place to prevent this happening again. The Sub-Committee was also satisfied by what it heard from the applicant regarding its good neighbour policy and was pleased to hear that they would be in contact with the Local Ward Councillor, Cllr Sam Pritchard to discuss concerns.

In relation to the conditions, the Sub-Committee imposed the existing conditions with one amendment that Think 21 be changed to Think 25.
