AREA AND JOINT PLANNING COMMITTEES

It was agreed by Council (25 October, 13 December 2005 and 22 July 2008, plus a date when Council agreed call-in for tree applications) that delegated items shown below which are emboldened (also marked with an asterisk) may be subject to reference to an Area or Joint Planning Committee.

- (a) With Town or Parish Support
 - Where within three weeks following the notification of the Waverley Weekly List of Planning Applications, a Ward Councillor for the Planning Area (for the Ward area including all or part of the planning application site) makes a request to that effect, supported in writing by the relevant Town or Parish Council, the application will be placed on the agenda for the next appropriate Area or Joint Planning Committee. This is provided that the Town or Parish Clerk has written to confirm that the Town or Parish Council has recommended it to the Ward Councillor for the Planning Area for consideration by an Area or Joint Planning Committee of Waverley Borough Council.
- (b) Member proposal to refer an application

Where within three weeks following the notification of the Waverley Weekly List of Planning Applications, a Ward Councillor for the Planning Area (for the Ward area including all or part of the planning application site) requests that an item be referred to a Ceommittee, and puts forward matters that are relevant planning grounds, officers will normally not exercise their delegated powers and instead submit the application to the appropriate eCommittee (including trees).
