- 5. Non-standard timings to be permitted on the following days: Christmas Eve; Christmas Day; Boxing Day; New Year's Day; Spring and August Bank Holidays; Good Friday; Easter Saturday, Sunday and Monday and any other Bank Holidays 10:30h to 01:00h.
- 6. Opening hours are as follows:

Monday to Thursday from 10:00h until 00:30h Friday and Saturday from 10:00h until 01:30h Sunday from 10:00h until 23:30

Noise management

- No regulated entertainment will be provided in the external areas.

- Signage will displayed at the premises reminding customers to leave quietly and respect the neighbours.
- The manager, licence holder or other competent person shall carry out observations outside in the premises periodically from 22:00h in order to establish whether there is a noise breakout from the premises. If the observation reveals noise breakout at a level likely to cause disturbance to the occupants of properties in the vicinity then noise levels will be turned down and/or customers will be asked to go indoors. A record of such observations shall be kept in a book for that purpose, such a book shall be completed immediately after the observation detailing the time, location and duration of the observation, the level of noise breakout and any action taken to reduce noise breakout. Such book to be kept at the premises.

Children

- Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times
- The premises will operate a "Challenge 25" policy whereby any person attempting to buy alcohol who appears to be under 25 will be asked for photographic ID to prove their age. The recommended forms of ID that will be accepted are passports, driving licences with a photograph, photographic military ID or proof of age cards bearing the 'PASS' mark hologram. The list of approved forms of ID may be amended or revised with the prior written agreement of Sussex Police and the Licensing Authority without the need to amend the licence or conditions attaching to it.
- After 21:00 hours, children may only remain on the premises if partaking in a sit down meal or a private function.

All other hours and licensable activities authorised by the premises licence are to remain unaltered.
