This is an application to change the layout of the premises in accordance with the submitted plan.

The main change is the addition of an external bar and extension to the premises to relocate the kitchen and therefore add more dining areas to the premises.

The application also seeks to permit licensable activities on the first floor as outlined on the plan.

In addition to the above changes to the layout, the application seeks to make the following changes:

- 1. Permit the sale of alcohol, recorded music, films and live music on New Year's Eve until 03:00h on New Year's Day.
- 2. As a result of point 1, the opening hours are to be permitted on New Year's Eve until 03:30h on New Year's Day.
- 3. Remove the existing nonstandard timings and replace them with the below:
- An additional hour from the end of permitted hours will be allowed on every Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, Boxing Day and New Year's Day. An additional hour from the end of permitted hours will be allowed on every Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday for each Bank Holiday weekend (Easter, May, Whitsun and August). An additional hour is also permitted on the day preceding a Friday Bank Holiday or Public Holiday.
- 4. Recorded music and the provision of films are to be added to the premises licence as follows:
- Monday to Saturday from 11:00h until 23:00h
- Sunday from 12:00h until 22:30h

Additionally, the application seeks to remove the following conditions as they are out of date, and no longer appropriate for the intended operation of the premises.

- 1. "One or two piece bands only on a maximum of 12 occasions per year" under Annex 2
- 2. "Limited by condition at hearing to 12 occasions per year, subject to 10 working days' notice (minimum) to Surrey Police, with Police having absolute right to veto" under Annex
- 3. All conditions under "Embedded Restrictions" under Annex 2
- 4. "No recorded music shall be permitted, including karaoke and disco" under Annex 3
- 5. "Live music events shall be limited to 12 occasions per year subject to 10 working

days' notice to Surrey Police and giving Police an absolute veto on all occasions" under Annex 3
All other hours, licensable activities and conditions authorised by the premises licence are to remain unaltered.
