



A WELL ESTABLISHED AND REPRECTED BUSINESS WHERE MOST OF THE ACTIVITIES APPLIED FOR ARE CURRENT UP IN OPENATION. ALL ACTIVITIES ARE SUPERVISED BY MANAGERS WHO ARE FIRST AID TRAINED, HEALTH AND SAFETY TRAINED AND WHO ARE CUSTOMER CARE SKULLS TRAINED.

# b) The prevention of crime and disorder

A COMPREHENSIVE CCTU SYSTEM IS IN PLACE ATTHE PREMISES, INCLUDING THE BAR ARGAS AND CAR PARLS. 16 (SIXTEEN) CAMERAS RECOLD 24 HRS PERDAY, 7 PAYS PER NEEK AND THE RECOLDINGS ARE SAVED FOR A MINIMUM OF 31 DAYS.

# c) Public safety

ALL MANAGERS ARE FIRST AID TRAINED. AN IN-HOUSE EXPERIENCED MAINTENANCE TRAM CALLY OUT A REGULAR, PRO-ACTIVE, PROGRAMME AIMED AT ENSURING THE BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS ARE FIT FOR PURPOSE.

## d) The prevention of public nuisance

AT THE END OF ALL EVENTS, MANAGERS MONITOR GUEST EGRESS TO ENSURE MINIMAL DISKUPTION. TAXID CAN BE ORDERED FOR GUESTS AT RECEPTION.

## e) The protection of children from harm

THE PREMISES OPERATES A 'CHALLENGE 21' POLICY AND ALL STAFF ARE TRAINED ACCOLDINGLY. STAFF INVOLVED IN THE SUPPLY OF ALCOHOL WILL BE TRAINED IN THE BASIC LAW DELATING TO THE SALLE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL TO PERSONS WINDER AGE.
