MINOR VARIATION DECISION

LICENSING ACT 2003 - APPLICATION FOR MINOR VARIATION OF EXISTING PREMISES LICENCE – THE ROYAL ARMS, 172 FARNBOROUGH ROAD, HEATHEND, FARNHAM, SURREY GU9 9AX

I write to confirm the outcome in respect of the above application, which Mr Hughes advised you of by telephone on Monday 14 September 2020.

Having regard to the application and the representations received, it is the Head of Environmental & Regulatory Services and the Licensing Managers opinion that the proposed amendment to remove a significant number of conditions from your licence (whilst having taken into account the need to modify operating practices to address Covid-19 precautions), would on balance, cumulatively and individually adversely impact on the Licensing Objective of Prevention of Public Nuisance.

Therefore the Minor Variation is REFUSED
