Sex Establishment Policy.

Thank you for asking Cranleigh Parish Council to comment on the above Policy. The Council would like to make the following comments:

- Although there is no legal requirement for the WBC to adopt this policy, the Parish Council is in agreement that it is very important to do so.
- Page 11. The Parish Council is quite surprised that a licence for a sexual entertainment venue is not required where relevant entertainment has not been provided on more than eleven occasions in any 12 months. In our opinion, any venue which offers sexual entertainment, no matter how often, should require a licence.
- Clause 8.4, please include Town and Parish Councils as relevant bodies to be consulted.
