Annexe 1 – Mandatory Conditions

Alcohol - Club

A club premises certificate may not authorise the supply of alcohol for consumption off the premises unless it also authorises the supply of alcohol to a member of the club for consumption on those premises. A club premises certificate which authorises the supply of alcohol for consumption off the premises must include the following conditions:

- The first condition is that the supply must be made at a time when the premises are open for the purposes of supplying alcohol, in accordance with the club premises certificate, to members of the club for consumption on the premises.
- The second condition is that any alcohol supplied for consumption off the premises must be in a sealed container.
- The third condition is that any supply of alcohol for consumption off the premises must be made to a member of the club in person.

Supply of alcohol to be for consumption : On the premises

ELEMENTS OF OPERATING SCHEDULE TO ADDRESS LICENSING OBJECTIVES:

a) General - all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e)

Only Club officials who have been trained in the serving of alcohol and who have knowledge of the Club's membership rules shall operate the bar.

The CCTV security system shall be maintained in good working order.

There shall continue to be full facilities for use by disabled members.

The premises shall close and be cleared 30 minutes after the sale of alcohol ceases.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

There shall be no advertising of the Club to the general public.

The premises shall continue to be monitored by the CCTV system on a 24 hour basis.

Consumption of alcohol shall only be permitted within the boundaries of the premises marked on the plan attached.

Only Club officers shall be permitted to serve alcohol.

The Club's alcohol shall continue to be stored behind the Chubb protected doors and grills.

The outside security lights shall be automatically controlled.

c) Public Safety

The premises shall have annual checks and maintenance of the fire safety equipment, alarm and central heating systems.

All equipment used for dispensing alcoholic and non-alcoholic refreshment shall be cleaned on a weekly basis.

Any out-of-date goods shall be returned to the vendor.

Public safety signage including fire exit routes shall be displayed on the premises, in accordance with the licence plan.

Local taxi telephone numbers shall be displayed.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

The on-site parking facilities, including a disabled area shall be maintained.

The gate providing access to the site shall be locked by not later than 2200 every night.

All functions shall take place within the premises and during functions, doors shall be kept closed.

Meeting shall continue to be held with the local residents in order to raise any issues with the Club's operations. The Club Committee undertakes that steps shall be taken as necessary to address these any problems.

e) The protection of children from harm

The comprehensive membership database which identifies members who are underage (Colts) shall be maintained and kept up-to-date.

All members shall be in possession of a club card which identifies members who are underage, as appropriate.

No alcohol shall be served to underage members.

The premises shall not provide internet access.

No entertainment of an adult nature shall take place on the premises.

Embedded Restrictions: Club

1. Permitted Hours

Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied except during permitted hours.

In this condition, permitted hours means:

- a) On weekdays, other than Christmas Day, Good Friday or New Year's Eve, 1000-2300
- b) On Sundays, other than Christmas Day or New Year's Eve, 1200-2230
- c) On Good Friday, 1200-2230
- d) On New Year's Eve, except on a Sunday, 1000-2300
- e) On New Year's Eve on a Sunday, 1200-2230
- f)On Christmas day, as provided by the rules of the club and notified in writing by the chairman or secretary of the club to the Licensing Authority in which the premises are. The said hours shall:
- i. not exceed six and a half hours;
- ii. not begin earlier than noon;
- iii. not end later than 2230;
- iv. provide for a break of at least 2 hours, including 1500-1700;
- v. not extend for more than three and a half hours after 1700;
- g) On New Year's Eve from the end of permitted hours to the start of permitted hours on the following day.

Restrictions

The above restrictions do not prohibit:

- a) the consumption of the alcohol on the premises by persons taking table meals there during the first thirty minutes after the above hours, if the alcohol was supplied for consumption ancillary to those meals;
- b) the consumption of the alcohol on the premises by, or, the taking sale or supply of alcohol to any person residing in the licensed premises;
- c) the sale of alcohol to a trader or club for the purposes of the trade or club;
- d) the sale or supply of alcohol to any canteen or mess, being a canteen in which the sale or supply of alcohol is carried out under the authority of the Secretary of State or an authorised mess of members of Her Majesty's naval, military or air forces;
- e) the taking of alcohol from the premises by a person residing there; or
- f) the supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to any private friends of a person residing there who are bona fide entertained by him at his own expense, or the consumption of alcohol by persons so supplied; or

g) the supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to persons employed there for the purposes of the business carried on by the holder of the licence, or the consumption of liquor so supplied, if the liquor is supplied at the expense of their employer or of the person carrying on or in charge of the business on the premises.

The licensee may also provide and permit entertainment by way of music and singing but <u>only</u> by the reproduction of recorded sound (this does not permit the use of karaoke, disk jockeys, comperes etc).
