#### Brewery and Taproom at Pierrepont Farm

I am writing in support of the licence application for the above. [REDACTED]

It is necessary unfortunately to view at least some of any negative remarks in context of the occasionally scurrilous disinformation campaign on this matter, made without regard it seems for the ill will created towards the farm, its owners and tenants, or indeed, factual accuracy. The aim of this appears to be to deprive Farnham Brewing of an economically feasible licence, and to render the premises unviable to any other brewer, thus also harming the Countryside Regeneration Trust, a charity.

To explain briefly the situation for tenants on the farm, [REDACTED] lease agreements are quite proscriptive in terms of behaviour, and specifically exclude any security of tenure. In practice this normally gives a convivial relationship since the CRT are a very considerate and responsive landlord, and [REDACTED] all working in a very pleasant place. Each tenant is well aware of how to conduct themselves, and that to persistently cause a problem for the landlord could cause them to lose patience. Rather than accept the simple explanation, some have decided to exact what they see as revenge, and feel entitled to take down the new tenant and the CRT a peg or two. To support someone in need is one thing, to actively run a vendetta is something else again. The people concerned ought to know better I feel, and could easily become involved and actually volunteer to do something useful on the farm, but choose instead to just interfere. I am afraid that you will receive objection letters from these people, consisting of locals who've otherwise frequently enjoyed the brewery to date, and others who are joining in on line and may even have never visited the farm.

I don't doubt that Farnham Brewing would make good landlords of the Tap Room. They bring competence of running a pub, and the necessary energy and resources to make a very good job of running the place. Each of the three involved have a family and live locally. This suits the clientele of the place, which is largely family-based. The idea to offer food should be especially popular since this was the case previously, attracting perhaps a hundred people, when at other times when no food was available attendance was rather less. Whoever runs the brewery, it is the location which attracts people, situated as it is on a beautiful farm, on the King Alfreds Cycleway, and in walking distance of Frensham Little Pond.

To respond to some of the negative points which have been made already:

Although there is not a huge amount of hard standing parking on site, I have never known it to be a problem for visitors to the brewery. The overall demand is mitigated by many visitors arriving on bicycle or on foot.

The main attraction of the brewery is its beautiful location. People come to visit from some distance, either by car or on cycle from the King Alfred's Cycleway. The place is therefore not in complete competition with any local village pubs given this broader catchment.

The taproom may be easily equipped as a café. The previous tenant served coffee, tea, cake, and ice cream. I understand that the National Trust welcome some relief to their nearby café at the pond at busy times.

I understand that there is disappointment that the hours for the site generally under the planning application doesn't take precedence over those stated in the license. I hope this is still the case, and that the licensed hours, which I believe are fewer than those of the prior license, will be approved. The disappointment gives some idea of the motivation behind the objection, and indeed has been the objectors' main hope to spoil the approval of the taproom. I understand there is also talk that the premises may be licensed to brew beer but not to serve it. I trust that there is in fact no such confusion since the licensing authority has approved licenses for the place before.

The new tenants, Farnham Brewing, consist of 3 local gentlemen who will doubtless be assisted by their families in running the business. This has been taken to mean an expansion by some, since the previous tenants were just a couple. I don't see that actual expansion is possible since the premises are of a limited size, and that the proposed activities are more a case of making the best of what is there. For example, the brewery has only been well-attended when food is on offer, and poorly attended otherwise. Making the effort to offer food more often should give better attendance. There's no expansion as such, just being more successful on a greater number of days.

In the time [REDACTED] at the farm I have never known any rowdiness at the brewery. The only time there was slightly inappropriate behaviour was following an article in the Daily Telegraph about Frensham Ponds, which resulted in the ponds being inundated with visitors, causing parking problems by the ponds, and just too many people. Some of the visitors made it onto the farm, and I recall that a small group of five or six youngsters had bought beer 'off-license' which they were told not to consume at the Tap Room. They wandered off up the pathway to find somewhere to drink their beer. They were civil and quiet, and not causing any disturbance other than drinking beer. In general, there is no public order issue at the brewery or on the farm. The only other incident has been recent, with some members of the public looking for an argument, having read and unfortunately believed some of the nonsense about the departure of the previous brewery tenant on line. I doubt this will persist.

To conclude, I strongly support the license application by Farnham Brewing, I think they'll do a great job of running the place rather nearer to its potential and keeping the family atmosphere. I am equally sure that many customers will also enjoy the place too, as they did before.

## LETTER OF SUPPORT

As Property Manager for The Countryside Regeneration Trust, owners of Pierrepont Farm, I write in support of this application.

The CRT were gifted Pierrepont Farm including a range of listed old dairy buildings. The dairy was moved to a new purpose built site leaving us the challenge to re-purpose the old buildings.

All relevant Planning Permissions and Listed Building Consents have been sought and granted where required, the most relevant being WA/2016/1882 which applies to the Brewery & Taproom.

I attach a copy of the planning officers report that confirms vehicular access and parking provision accords with the policies required. Access from the public highway is down the access road which forms part of the estate. This is in a good state of repair and subject to continual improvement including the provision of further passing places.

Impact on residential amenity is also addressed and it was considered unjustifiable to impose previous conditions due to the site being further removed from residential property.

The Brewery and Taproom are unencumbered by any restrictive conditions on operating hours unlike other premises on site. Despite this the applicants are seeking very similar operating hours that were granted to the previous tenant.

The Farnham Brewery Co wish to build on the steady growth and development of the site for the benefit of the other on site tenants and the local community, doing so in a responsible manner.

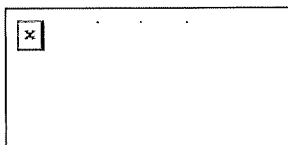
