

RE: Breakdown of variations to the Lounge Bar's License

To Whom It May Concern:

Here is a break down of the variations currently applied for:

Variation of area covered for licensable activities:

We have knocked the kitchen through and made the private hire room slightly bigger and added seats and a service bar. The main objective is to create a chill out room/ private hire room. A member of staff will be permanently employed to look after guests in this area at all times every time the space is open. As well as the sufficiently trained bartender, a cocktail waitress will frequent the space to ensure cleanliness. We would like this area to be covered for licensable activities as per our current license.

Change of capacity:

With the additional space, our capacity will be slightly more than 100 as per our current license. In most instances we leave out seats for added comfort. On special events we may clear furniture to clear dance floor. This affects capacity. We propose that the license holder responsibly manage capacity to no more than 150 people.

Regulation of patrons smoking outside:

A maximum 5 people are currently allowed outside smoking at any one time. We propose the limit be enforced after 11pm with a maximum of 15 patrons on Fridays and Saturdays, of which the smoking area will be the sides of the building hence discouraging people to stay out longer than normal. Our door staff will take an active roll to insure that the main street stays relatively clear. This also directs the noise away from the main street, as there are no residents on the left hand side of the building.

Last entry or re-entry Policy:

Currently, no patrons are allowed into the premises after midnight. We propose discretion for industry workers, friends and family. Most pub and restaurant workers in Godalming like to enjoy a late night refreshment and wind down at the Lounge Bar after they finish work of which most of them finish work around midnight. Either we extend the policy to 12.30am or keep it at 12am but make exception for industry workers. The Lounge is an active member of the Pub Watch community so this should be easy to manage.

Variation of Under 14s Policy:

Patrons under the age of 14 are currently NOT allowed in the premises. We propose NO AGE LIMIT, but the following to be imposed: Entry by U18s to be strictly accompanied by a responsible adult over the age of 21 and children monitored at all times. Any persons under 18 will be required to vacate by 8pm. With major sporting events coming soon, such as the rugby world cup, we aim to attract families during daytime.
