Annexe 1 – Mandatory Conditions

Films

The admission of children under the age of 18 to film exhibitions permitted under the terms of this licence shall be restricted in accordance with any recommendations made

- a. By the British Board of Film Classification (BBFC) where the film has been classified by that Board, or
- b. By the Licensing Authority where no classification certificate has been granted by the BBFC, or, where the licensing authority has notified the licence holder that section 20 (3) of the Licensing Act 2003 applies to the film.

Alcohol

No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence:

- At a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence.
- At a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.

Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

- 1. (1) The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.
 - (2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance, or harm to children:-
 - (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to:-
 - (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
 - (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);

- (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other than any promotion or discount available to an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at a table meal, as defined in section 159 of the Act);
- (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less;
- (d) provision of free or discounted alcohol in relation to the viewing on the premises of a sporting event, where that provision is dependent on:-
 - (i) the outcome of a race, competition or other event or process, or
 - (ii) the likelihood of anything occurring or not occurring;
- (e) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.
- 2. The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).
- 3. The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.
- 4. (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
 - (2) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.
- 5. The responsible person shall ensure that:-
 - (a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures:-
 - (i) beer or cider: ½ pint;
 - (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
 - (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and
 - (b) customers are made aware of the availability of these measures.

ELEMENTS OF OPERATING SCHEDULE TO ADDRESS LICENSING OBJECTIVES:

a) General - all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e)

The licensees shall have regard to the licensing objectives and the Council's Statement of Licensing Policy.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

There shall be a 30 minute wind-down period after the sale of alcohol ceases, in which there shall be access to the pub's toilet facilities.

Not less than 10 working days written notice shall be provided to the Police for 12 non-specific events.

CCTV shall be installed to the satisfaction of the Police within 12 months of the grant of the licence.

c) Public Safety

Function bookings in the first floor room shall be limited to 50 persons.

Function bookings in the garden marquee shall be limited to 65 persons.

In those areas where a capacity appliers, the numbers shall be controlled by the licensees and the DPS.

The capacity number shall in every case include all staff and performers.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

No live or recorded music shall be played in the garden, or any marquee placed there, after 23:00. Live music indoors shall end at 00:00 (23:30 Sunday - Wednesday)

The volume of recorded music shall be reduced to background level after 00:00 on special event days.

At least one member of staff shall obtain SIA doorstaff qualifications as well as their personal licence and shall be on duty whenever live music, DJ music and/or dancing are provided to the general public.

where such activities are part of private party events, the hirer shall be asked to control entry only to the invited guests.

e) The protection of children from harm

The licensees and all staff shall have regard to the restrictions set out in the Licensing Act 2003. Proof of age shall be required of anyone who appears to be under 20 years old.

1. Means of Escape

The bar area shall be restricted to a maximum of 100 (one hundred) people until the third exit is made available at all material times (SFRS letter dated 30/06/05).
